

Jewish wedding timeline

Date: July 22, 2026

Timeline

13:00 – 14:00 First Look and Couple Portraits

The couple meets for their first look prior to the ceremonies and poses for formal photographs with immediate family and the wedding party.

Location: Grand Garden Lawn

14:30 – 15:15 Ketubah Signing

The couple, rabbi, close family, and official witnesses gather in private to sign the sacred Jewish marriage contract.

Location: Bridal Suite

15:20 – 15:40 Badeken (Veiling Ceremony)

The groom veils the bride amidst singing and blessings from family, confirming her identity before proceeding to the Chuppah.

Location: Reception Foyer

15:45 – 16:00 Guest Seating at Chuppah

Guests are directed to their seats in the courtyard while live musicians play traditional pre-ceremony melodies.

Location: Outdoor Courtyard

16:00 – 16:45 Chuppah Ceremony

The wedding ceremony includes the exchange of rings, chanting of the Seven Blessings (Sheva Brachot), and the traditional breaking of the glass.

Location: Outdoor Courtyard

16:45 – 17:15 Yichud (Private Time)

The newlyweds spend their first quiet moments alone together to break their fast and reflect on the ceremony.

Location: Private Yichud Suite

17:15 – 18:15 Cocktail Hour

Guests enjoy kosher appetizers and signature cocktails while socialising before the main reception begins.

Location: Terrace Balcony

18:15 – 18:30 Grand Entrance & First Dance

The couple is enthusiastically welcomed into the ballroom and performs their romantic first dance as husband and wife.

Location: Grand Ballroom

18:30 – 19:15 The Hora & Traditional Dancing

A high-energy Jewish celebratory dance featuring the famous lifting of the couple on chairs amidst circle dancing.

Location: Grand Ballroom

19:15 – 20:30 Festive Dinner & Speeches

Guests enjoy a gourmet multi-course dinner interspersed with heartfelt toasts from family members and close friends.

Location: Grand Ballroom

20:30 – 20:45 Birkat Hamazon & Sheva Brachot

The traditional grace after meals is recited, followed by the repeating of the Seven Blessings over wine.

Location: Grand Ballroom

20:45 – 23:00 Open Dancing & Celebration

The live band keeps the dance floor packed with contemporary hits and festive music until the end of the evening.
