

Mobile clinic schedule

Date: July 23, 2026

Timeline

07:00 – 07:30 Depot Departure and Vehicle Prep

Medical staff conduct morning safety checks, restock essential medical supplies, and initialize onboard diagnostic systems. The mobile unit departs the main garage promptly after team briefing.

Location: Central Medical Depot

07:30 – 08:00 Transit to Stop 1

The clinic travels to its first scheduled destination of the day. Driver monitors traffic conditions while medical staff review patient pre-registrations.

Location: Transit Route 1

08:00 – 08:30 Clinic Setup and System Check

Staff deploy stabilizing jacks, set up outdoor check-in canopies, and power up refrigeration and medical workstations. Queue management signs are placed for patient direction.

Location: Eastside Community Center

08:30 – 10:30 Morning Health Screenings

Healthcare providers offer blood pressure checks, cholesterol screenings, and general wellness consultations. Prescriptions are dispensed for routine treatments.

Location: Eastside Community Center

10:30 – 10:45 Staff Refreshment Break

A brief intermission for staff to rest, hydrate, and re-stock consultation stations. Quick equipment sterilization is completed during this time.

Location: Eastside Community Center

10:45 – 11:15 Transit to Stop 2

The mobile clinic moves across town to the designated senior living facility. Onboard staff sanitize surfaces during transit.

Location: Transit Route 2

11:15 – 13:15 Senior Care & Immunization Drive

Nurses administer seasonal flu shots, pneumonia vaccines, and mobility evaluations tailored for elderly residents. Wheelchair-accessible ramps are deployed.

Location: Oakridge Senior Living

13:15 – 14:00 Lunch Break and Midday Restock

Medical personnel take a meal break while logistics coordinators secure hazardous waste containers and replenish cold-chain vaccine storage.

Location: Oakridge Senior Living

14:00 – 14:30 Transit to Stop 3

The vehicle travels to the downtown plaza for afternoon outreach services. Fleet telematics record mileage and vehicle efficiency.

Location: Transit Route 3

14:30 – 16:30 Afternoon Urgent & Preventive Care

Clinicians treat minor injuries, conduct dental triage, and distribute hygiene packs to urban community members. Social workers are present to offer resource referrals.

Location: Downtown Plaza Park

16:30 – 17:00 Tear Down and Depot Return

Exterior equipment and canopies are packed away securely inside the mobile unit. The vehicle travels back to the central base.

Location: Transit Route 4

17:00 – 17:30 Decontamination and Reporting

The interior undergoes medical-grade UV and chemical disinfection. Staff log patient statistics and submit daily clinic performance reports.

Location: Central Medical Depot
