

Museum launch day

8:00 AM – 9:00 AM Staff Briefing

Main Lobby

Museum staff meet at the main entrance to review the day's schedule and logistics. Everyone is briefed on emergency protocols and visitor flow.

9:30 AM – 10:00 AM Media Hour

Grand Hall

Exclusive access for journalists and photographers to capture the exhibits before doors open. Interviews with the museum curator are conducted.

10:00 AM – 10:30 AM Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

Front Entrance

The museum director gives a short address followed by the ceremonial cutting of the ribbon. Dignitaries and local officials are in attendance.

10:30 AM – 11:30 AM Guided Tour A

History Wing

The first group of visitors is taken through the history wing by a professional guide. Participants learn about the origins of the museum collection.

12:00 PM – 1:00 PM Catering Lunch

Museum Terrace

A lunch service is provided for VIP guests and museum board members. Light refreshments and sandwiches are served.

1:30 PM – 2:30 PM Guided Tour B

Art Gallery

Visitors are guided through the modern art installation. The guide discusses the creative process behind the featured works.

3:00 PM – 3:30 PM Keynote Speech

Auditorium

A renowned historian delivers a speech about the importance of cultural preservation. The audience is invited to a short Q&A session afterwards.

4:00 PM – 5:30 PM Afternoon Tea and Drinks

Museum Cafe

A social hour for attendees to relax and discuss the exhibits. Complimentary drinks and snacks are available to all guests.

6:00 PM – 7:00 PM Closing Ceremony

Grand Hall

A final toast is offered to the volunteers and donors who made the launch possible. The museum doors

officially close for the evening.
